

# God's Faithfulness

*“The Lord’s loving-kindnesses indeed never cease, for His compassions never fail, they are new every morning: GREAT IS THY FAITHFULNESS!”  
Lamentations 3:22-23*

To be faithful means “to be steadfast in affection or allegiance, loyal , firm in adherence to promises or in observance of duty; conscientious, binding, constant, given with strong assurance” (Webster). **This definition describes God perfectly!**

**Faithfulness is one of Almighty God’s greatest attributes.** God is steadfast in His love and care for us. He never wavers. His unconditional love is binding. It’s ours through divine covenant. Nothing can ever separate us from His love. We can depend on our heavenly Father to love us even when we don’t love ourselves! His affection for His children is constant. Never changes. That’s faithfulness.

God makes promises in His Word. In faithfulness, **HE PERFORMS WHAT HE PROMISES.** God is faithful to keep His Word. He never breaks His promises. **God is the ultimate promise keeper!**

**PEACE PRODUCING PRINCIPLE:** The Lord Jesus Christ is who He says He is and He does what He says He will do.

As a Christian, **YOU CAN COUNT ON GOD!** He is the Faithful One! **HE CAN BE TRUSTED!** He will always come through for you because He cannot be unfaithful. It is not in His holy nature to not be faithful.

*It is not possible for the Lord to fail to keep covenant with you.* His covenant is an “*everlasting covenant*” (Genesis 17:7) that He has committed Himself to keep for all generations who believe in him. Men may let you down. God never will!

\*\*\* Meditate on the following Scriptures. Decide for yourself that God is faithful. Then, determine to walk by faith, being diligent to wholeheartedly trust the Faithful One to meet your every need through Jesus Christ.

- **“Thou has dealt well with Thy servant, O Lord, according to Thy Word.”**  
Psalm 119:65
- **“Faithful is He** that calls you, for he will bring it to pass.” I Thessalonians 5:24

- “And behold, **I am with you, and will keep you** in all the places you will go, and will bring you again into this land; **for I will not leave, until I have done** that which I have spoken to you of.” Genesis 28:15
- But because the Lord loved you, **and because He would keep His oath** which He had sworn to your fathers, has the Lord brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of the bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh King of Egypt. **Know therefore that the Lord Thy God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations.** Deuteronomy 7:8-9
- “And, behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth; and you know in all your hearts and in all your souls, **that not one thing has failed of all the good things which the Lord your God spoke concerning you; all are come to pass unto you, and not one thing has failed.**” Joshua 23:14
- “Thy mercy, O Lord, is in the heavens; and **Thy faithfulness** reaches unto the clouds.” Psalm 36:5
- “I will sing of the mercies of the Lord forever, with my mouth I will make known **Thy faithfulness** to all generations. For I have said, mercy shall be built up forever; Thy faithfulness shall Thou establish in the very heavens. Nevertheless, **My lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor allow My faithfulness to fail. My covenant I will not break, nor will I alter anything that has gone out of My lips.**” Psalm 89:1-2, 33-34
- **“He will not allow your foot to be moved;** He that keeps you will not sleep. Behold, He that keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.” Psalm 121:3-4
- “...Because of the Lord, **who is faithful,** the Holy One of Israel has chosen you.”

Isaiah 49:7

- **“God is faithful,** by whom you were called unto the fellowship of His Son Jesus Christ our Lord.” I Corinthians 1:9
- “There is no temptation that has overtaken you that is not common to man; **but God is faithful,** and He will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able to bear; but will with the temptation also make a way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.” I Corinthians 10:13
- **“The Lord is not slow about His promise** as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish, but for all to come to repentance.”

Peter 3:9

- “Let your character be free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, **“I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU.”** Hebrews 13:5
- “If we do not believe, **yet He abides faithful; He cannot deny Himself.** Nevertheless, the foundation of God stands sure, having this seal, the Lord knows them that are His.” II Timothy 2:13,19
- “And without becoming weak in faith he (Abraham) contemplated his own body, now as good as dead since he was about a hundred years old, and the deadness of Sarah’s womb; **yet with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief, but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully assured that what He had promised, He was able also to perform.”** Romans 4:19-21
- “Surely my soul remembers and is bowed down within me. This I recall to my mind, therefore I have hope.
